Dear Bruce:

Pursuant to Section 1.III.C of the Remedial Investigation/ Feasibility Study Statement of Work (RI/FS SOW), EPA will give the Respondents Notice to Proceed (NTP) for any Engineering Evaluation and Cost Analysis (EE/CA) conducted at the site. This letter serves as a Notice to Proceed to the Respondents to develop an EE/CA for the remediation of the facility buildings and the contents of those buildings at the Nuclear Metals Superfund site.

In addition, pursuant to paragraph 16 of the Nuclear Metals Superfund site Administrative Order by Consent (AOC), Docket No. CERCLA 01-2003-0021, the EE/CA will be considered a deliverable subject to EPA approval and will be reviewed in accordance with such paragraph. A public comment period is also required, and in accordance with Sections 5 and 6 in the RI/FS SOW, the Respondents shall assist EPA in preparing a responsiveness summary once the public comment period has ended.
