Five parties responsible for contaminating a Concord Superfund site with hazardous waste have agreed to fund studies aimed at developing a cleanup plan, the Environmental Protection Agency announced yesterday.

As part of the studies, buried drums of waste will be located and groundwater and soil tested at the Sarmet Corp. site, where depleted uranium armor piercing bullets were made until 1999.

The Army and the Department of Energy will pay 98 percent of the costs, while Whittaker Corp., MONY Life Insurance Co. and Textron Inc. will pay 2 percent.
